

King's Awareness Scholarship Application

One scholarship of \$2,000 will be awarded each year to a full-time student who is from a high school in Canada which King's has not received a student from in the previous two years. To be eligible students must apply, have an average of 70% or higher on high school entrance marks, and provide a statement outlining their involvement in high school activities. Recipients of this scholarship can have the award renewed up to three times if they maintain a 2.70 or higher grade point average, and submit a written letter to their high school newspaper (preferable), principal, or guidance counsellor describing their experience as a King's student. If the scholarship is renewed by the most recent recipient, the award will not be available that year for a new incoming student.

To process this application, The King's University must collect applicants' personal information, such as an individual's name, home address, phone number, age, sex, marital status, financial information, and education history.
