## Eligibility, Requirements, and Procedures

*Read all information carefully and complete all required sections.*

Students must submit applications and all supporting documentation online by March 31, 2026. Results will be available in **May**.

### Course Load and Mark Requirements

Students must meet these requirements prior to receiving their award disbursement unless the award description says otherwise:

**To be eligible for scholarships**, students must register for at least **12 credits** per term. Scholarships generally require that students demonstrate a minimum GPA of 3 – 3.5 (or 80% or higher for high school applicants). If award descriptions do not list a minimum grade requirement, King’s will use these minimums to determine eligibility.

**To be eligible for bursaries**, students must register for at least **9 credits** per term. Scholarships generally require that students demonstrate a minimum GPA of 2 – 2.5 G.P.A. (or, 70 – 75% for high school applicants). If award descriptions do not list a minimum grade requirement, King’s will use these minimums to determine eligibility.

Award money will be disbursed in two halves; one half of the total award amount in late September and the other half in late January, pending the confirmation of award eligibility. If students only attend for the fall term, they will only receive half of the total award amount offered.

Students who do not have personal computers may use public library facilities and/or those located on the King’s campus to submit their application.
